3. To reach base extensions from the city, dial all seven digits of the number desired.
4. To reach base operator or base information from the city dial 773-1110.

**GOOD TELEPHONE USAGE PROCEDURES:**

**A. Authorized Use:** Military telephones and voice facilities are authorized FOR GOVERNMENT OFFICIAL USE ONLY and must be restricted to calls essential to the accomplishment of the mission. These calls should stand the scrutiny required if the same calls were commercial. To properly originate and answer telephone calls, it is recommended that:

1. When you receive a telephone call: Answer promptly. Identify yourself and your office when answering. Speak distinctly and pleasantly. Volunteer the whereabouts or time of return of an absent person and offer your assistance. Request the identity of a caller politely. Explain off-the-line delays. Take a message willingly and promptly deliver it.

2. When you make a telephone call: Plan your conversation. Insure that you have the correct number. Place the call yourself when possible. Identify yourself immediately when the distant end answers.

**DEFENSE SWITCHED NETWORK (DSN):**

**A. General:** The DSN is the principal long haul, voice communications network within the Defense Communications System. DSN provides UNSECURE direct distance dialing service through automatic switching facilities. The purpose of DSN is to handle essential command and control, operations, intelligence, logistic, diplomatic and administrative traffic.

**B. Precedence:** The Joint Uniform Telephone Communications Precedence System explains the use of precedence. Since the effectiveness of the system depends upon the cooperation on the part of the persons authorized to employ it, users must be familiar with the precedence system. See page 5.

**C. Overseas Calls:** All overseas DSN calls must be placed through the base operator. (Except 317-Alaska and 318 Saudi)

**D. Use of the DSN:**

1. Will be authorized for official communications only.

2. Will be restricted to:

(a) Only those calls that are essential, requiring a timeliness that cannot be obtained by other means, and would stand the scrutiny afforded a commercial call.

(b) The minimum time required to accomplish the official business and will not normally exceed 5 minutes.

(c) The use of a precedence level in consonance with the subject matter of the call as established in the Joint Uniform Telephone Communications Precedence System.

(d) The use of graphic, facsimile or unsecured voice-data devices only when approved by USAF/SCMM.

3. Will not be authorized for:

(a) Use directly or indirectly by any non-appropriated fund activities (clubs, exchanges, and other unofficial activities) provided telephone service at post-camp, camp, station or base level is available. The Joint Chiefs of Staff must approve exceptions.

(b) Calls within an installation, metropolitan area, or those confined geographical areas where other existing government provided local telephone service is adequate.

(c) Unofficial or personal calls

(d) Off-net extension calls into the commercial system at a distant PBX/PABX, except where such extension has been previously approved by the local authorities controlling the switch-board.

**E. Telephone COMSEC Monitoring:** The users of the DSN system should be aware that this DOD system is For Official Use Only, and is subject to management monitoring in accordance with AFI 33-219 and DODD 4640.1.

**F. DSN Users Calling Instructions**

1. Routine DSN calls:

(a) Users with dial-access to DSN from Class "A" telephones should;

(1) Verify the DSN number.

(2) Dial the DSN access code "94" plus seven digit number.

(b) Users with operator only access to DSN should:

(1) Verify the DSN number.

(2) Dial "0" and give the information to the telephone operator.

(A) DSN number desired.

(B) Remain on line while the operator completes the call.

2. Precedence and inter-area DSN calls: To place precedence of inter- area DSN calls, all users should:

(a) Verify the DSN number.

(b) Dial "0" and give the operator the following information:

(1) Precedence of call.

(2) DSN number desired.

(3) Remain on the line while the operator completes the call.

**G. DSN Assistance:** Call assistance, conferencing and directory assistance for DSN, is provided by the Base Information Operator by dialing ext 113.

**H. DSN Users Trouble Reporting:** When users utilizing DSN encounter trouble, the following procedures should be taken:

1. Call the 90th Communications Squadron Help Desk, at ext 4545.
2. Give all details possible pertaining to the DSN trouble encountered:
  - (a) Your extension number and location.
  - (b) The DSN number and location of the called party.
  - (c) Brief description of the trouble and the time it occurred.

\*Note - Items requiring repair, such as frayed cords and broken telephone parts are not DSN troubles. These should be reported to the Help Desk as a separate problem, at ext 4545.

## JOINT ARMY NAVY AIR FORCE PUBLICATION UNIFORM TELEPHONE COMMUNICATIONS PRECEDENCE SYSTEM (JANAP 137)

**A.** There are four levels of the Joint Uniform Telephone Communications Procedures System (JUTPCS) in the telephone procedure system, established for telephone calls placed within the Defense Communication System. At this base their use is confined to the Defense Switched Network (DSN). For further reference, consult AFI 33-111.

1. **FLASH:** Has precedence over any other telephone call of lower precedence. Flash may be preempted by the application of the FLASH OVERRIDE capability available to the National Command Authorities (NCA). These are reserved for alerts, warnings or other emergency actions having immediate bearing on nation, command or area security.

2. **IMMEDIATE:** Has precedence over any other telephone call of lower precedence. Preempts lower precedence calls. Precedence is reserved for vital communications:

- (a) Which have an immediate operational effect on tactical operations.
- (b) Which directly concern safety or rescue operations.
- (c) Which affect the intelligence community operational role.

3. **PRIORITY:** Is reserved for calls that require prompt completion for national defense and security, the successful conduct of war, or to safeguard life or property, which do not require a higher precedence. Normally PRIORITY is the highest precedence assigned to administrative matters, for which speed of handling is of utmost importance (i.e. reports of priority land, sea, or air movement; administrative intelligence; operational or logistic activity calls requiring priority action; calls that would have a serious impact on military and administrative intelligence, operational or logistic activities if handled as a routine precedence).

4. **ROUTINE:** Has no precedence over any other call and is handled as placed by the calling party. Precedence is reserved for all other official communications.

## REQUEST FOR TELEPHONE SERVICE:

The following procedures will apply when requesting new telephone installations, moves or new jack installations. Requests for telephone installations, moves or new jack installs should be submitted to your TCOs, who will call them into the Communications Squadron Help Desk (4545). The Unit Telephone Control Officer (TCO) of the requesting agency is the only individual authorized to request these services. Any Unauthorized requests (not requested by the TCO) will be rejected and returned to the Unit TCO for their review and approval/disapproval.

## REPORTING OPERATOR SERVICE:

Telephone operators are instructed to be courteous and alert at all times. However, in case of unsatisfactory service, ask for the operator's number (only), as the operators are not permitted to disclose their names or other related information.

1. Report unsatisfactory service to the 90 CS/QAP at 2040.
2. Telephone users should not admonish operators or attempt to engage them in idle conversation.
3. Obscene or harassing language over the telephone will not be tolerated. Federal and state statutes deal with offenders of this type. Title -47 U.S.C. 223; May 1968 covers offenses of this nature. Military and DAF civilian employees engaging in this action are also subject to disciplinary action under the Uniform Code of Military Justice.

## TROUBLE REPORTS:

Report all telephone malfunctions to Comm. Help Desk at extension 4545. If maintenance response is considered unsatisfactory, call the Telephone Systems Supervisor at ext. 3216.

## FEDERAL TELEPHONE SERVICE (FTS)

This system is for only designated class "A" telephone subscribers on F. E. Warren AFB. If you want to call someone on this system follow the procedure below, using an authorize Personal Identification Number (PIN).

1. Long Distance: Dial 98 plus Area Code then the seven-digit number after the stuttered tone, enter your pin number.
2. In State: Dial 98 plus 307 and the seven-digit number after the stuttered tone, enter your pin number.
3. 800 Numbers: Dial 99 plus 1-800- seven-digit number.
4. Information: Dial 98 plus Area Code then 555-1212 after the stuttered tone, enter your pin number.

When you use the FTS, the call will be billed to your designated class "A" telephone. All long distance "Official Government" calls should be placed through FTS.

## GENERAL INFORMATION SECTION

A Personal Identification Number (PIN) must be requested through your Unit TCO, who will procure the Pin number through the 90 CS Help Desk at ext. 4545. PIN numbers will only be issued through the TCOs.

### LONG DISTANCE SERVICE:

Official long distance calls from this base should be made only when time prohibits any other means of communications. All calls should be kept to minimum duration. To minimize the length of a call it is suggested that conversations be planned and all necessary notes, data, etc., be assembled in advance. The called party should be requested to return call if research is necessary. Calls should not exceed three minutes unless absolutely necessary.

Use the following procedures when placing long distance calls:

1. From Designated Class "A" Telephones: Dial 98 plus Area Code then the seven digit number and your pin number.
2. Toll Free Calls: To place Toll Free calls from a Class "A" telephone, dial "99 1800 plus your seven digit number.
3. Incoming Collect Calls (Emergency): Determine that the incoming collect call is an Emergency before accepting it.
4. Outgoing Collect Calls: When calling from a Class "A" telephone, dial "99 1", then 800-265-5328 for collect calls.
5. Control Records: Anyone responsible for the assignment of pin numbers for official long distance telephone calls must insure that every call is recorded on AF Form 1072, Authorized Long Distance Telephone Calls. All calls, including incoming and outgoing, must be identified. AF Form 1072 will cover the period from the first of each month through the end of the month. Control Records will be kept by each TCO, IAW provisions of AFI 33-111, Section B Para 8, 8.1.

### TELEPHONE INFORMATION:

Telephone information service for on base may be reached by dialing 113. To reach information from off base for a base extension, the telephone user must dial 773-1110 and ask for base information. We cannot provide information for local, state or out of state as there is a charge imposed on all information calls. Information for out of state may be obtained only if you have a billing number or an off-base number to bill the call to.

### UNOFFICIAL TELEPHONE SERVICE:

Personnel living in base quarters or dormitories desiring commercial telephone service will make a request to Qwest. Toll free number is 1-800-244-1111. Upon departure from F. E. Warren AFB, individuals are responsible for termination of such services.

### SECURE VOICE COMMUNICATIONS INSTRUCTIONS:

Classified information will not be discussed over the telephone, unless equipped with an authorized encryption device specifically approved for that purpose.

Secure Telephone Equipment: STE telephones are located throughout the base. You should use the STE in your DCS/Unit for all secure calls. If your DCS/Unit does not have a STE, contact the 90MW Command Post, Bldg 250, and use theirs. Use of the STE is for all personnel who have a requirement to conduct official business. Contact the controller on duty at the Command Post, ext 3921, for use of the STE.

### REPORTING NUISANCE CALLS:

Nuisance calls will be reported to the Security Police Desk Sergeant, ext 3501

### BOMB THREAT:

Bomb threat procedures are as follows: Try to keep the caller on the line and have another individual contact the security police at **ext. 911**. Do not hang up the telephone on which the bomb threat is received; try to keep the caller on line. Try to watch the time the call is received to help in the tracing action.

#### **SEE PAGE 10 FORM A THREAT AID FORM**

If unable to notify security forces while the call was in progress, notify immediately after caller hangs up. Have someone standby outside the building to assist in search of the building upon arrival of Law Enforcement Personnel. Any person who has information or knows the identity of person(s) placing a bomb threat or threatening telephone calls can notify security forces at ext. 3501 and remain anonymous.

### MINIMIZE:

**A.** MINIMIZE is a condition imposed by commanders to control and reduce electrical/voice communications during exercises or period of emergency. During these periods all except vital traffic must be drastically reduced. MINIMIZE may be imposed on all telephone, Teletype, commercial service and data systems. A telephone MINIMIZE will affect such services as DSN, long distance, telephone data, and administrative calls. All systems of services may be MINIMIZED as required by the imposing authority.

**B.** Normally, the Base Communications Center will receive the initial notification and will advise all base agencies through their administrative sections. Your unit's administrative section

will notify you when this condition exists. Responsibility for calls placed during this condition rests with each unit's Commander and TCO.

**C.** When MINIMIZE is in effect, subscribers may be denied direct dial access to the DSN, and commercial systems. Only calls approved by designated officials will be made. Telephone operators will inform all subscribers of the MINIMIZE prior to processing any outgoing calls through the switchboard.

### TELEPHONE CLASSIFICATIONS:

Telephones installed on F. E. Warren AFB are classified in accordance with AFI 33-111.

**A.** CLASS "A", telephones are authorized for the transaction of OFFICIAL GOVERNMENT business and are permitted access to all the city trunks by dialing "99" and the seven digit number. Personal long distance calls will not be placed from Class "A" telephones. Class "A" service has access to DSN by dialing "94" followed by the seven digit number.

**B.** Class "C", telephones are restricted to official inter-base business, and have no access to city or DSN trunks however, incoming city, pre-paid long distance and DSN calls may be accepted. Only the first number of a rotary type number should be listed and if you have a Class "A" and Class "C" telephone, only the class "C" should be listed in the telephone directory.

### DAMAGE TO COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT:

If equipment is tampered with, it will be removed from service immediately. Whoever willfully or maliciously injures or destroys any of the works or property of any radio, telephone, telegraph, cable, station, system or other means of communications operated or controlled by the USAF, whether constructed or in the process of construction or willfully or maliciously interferes in any way with the working or use of such line or system shall be fined not more than \$250,000 or imprisoned for not more than ten years or both. (Title 18, U.S.C. 1362, Chapter 65).

### PERSONAL TELEPHONE CALLS:

Personal calls from government telephones are not permitted except in cases of emergency. Pay station telephones are conveniently located throughout the base and will be used for all personal calls. Persons having a telephone on their desk are responsible for its proper use. Supervisors are expected to cooperate in insuring strict compliance with this instruction.

### CONFERENCE CALLS:

There are two types of conference systems available to F. E. Warren personnel. They are as follows:

**A.** Meet-me-conference: Allows many conferees to participate in a conference by calling into a pre-authorized number ext. 3033. To reserve a date and time, dial 0. You will call all conferees and advise them what number to dial and the time for the conference. If you are the first to dial into the conference you will hear a ring back dial tone, until other conferees dial in.

**B.** Operator Established Conference: Dial "0" and provide the operator with the numbers for your conference once the operator establish you conference they will release from it.

### DIRECTORY PUBLICATIONS:

**A.** The F. E. Warren Telephone Directory is published once a year.

**B.** Submission of Information: The published directory itself can be current only at the time of printing. Prompt submission of information by the subscriber is essential. Delay of notification to the Telephone Supervisor will result in correction arriving too late for inclusion in the new edition of the telephone directory. Organizations and staff agencies are requested to appoint individuals to be responsible for changes within their respective areas and to report the information promptly to the Telephone Supervisor. Minor changes such as incorrect spelling or telephone number changes should be reported by telephone to the Supervisor of Telephone Systems at ext. 3216. If the revision is extensive, it may be reported to 90CS/SCOT by letter or E-Mail.

### DSN CONFERENCE PROCEDURES:

DSN conferencing is available by contacting the DSN Assistance Operator at "94 0", and stating the telephone numbers required for the conference desired on routine calls. Priority and higher conference calls must be processed through the F. E. Warren AFB DSN Operator by dialing "0" for Immediate or Priority.

## HOW TO USE SPECIAL TELEPHONE FEATURES

\*Note- Phones may not have these features. Single line phones refer to phones with only 1 or 2 line capability

Digital phones refer to phones that can have more than 2 lines and have windows next to keys.

### A. Last Number Redial: (Will redial last successfully completed call)

- 1) Lift handset from cradle.
- 2) Press # #
- 3) Last number dialed will ring.

### B. Call Transfer:

- 1) Advise the calling party that you are going to transfer the call.
- 2) Press the link button on single line phones or transfer key on digital phones. (You will hear a second dial tone).
- 3) Dial the new extension.
- 4) Wait for ring, press transfer again.
- 5) Replace the handset in cradle.

### C. Three-Way Calling: (with the original caller still on the line)

- 1) Press the link key (single line) or the transfer key (digital) (You will hear a second dial tone)
- 2) Dial the third party's extension.
- 3) When the Third party answers, press the transfer button again.
- 4) All three parties are connected and can talk.

### D. Call Forward:

- 1) To Activate:
  - a) On Single line and digital phones without Call Forward buttons:
    - 1) Lift the handset from the cradle.
    - 2) Dial the call forward activation code: \*72 (You will hear stuttered dial tone and then a steady dial tone).
    - 3) Dial the 4-digit number you want your calls to forward to. (You will hear 2 short beeps).
    - 4) Replace the handset in the cradle.
    - 5) To verify the number to which calls are being forwarded, dial your own number from your own telephone. Your call should be forwarded to that number.
  - b) On digital phones with Call Forward buttons:
    - 1) With receiver in the cradle (hung up) press the Call Forward (Call Fwd) button.
    - 2) An arrow will begin to flash in window next to button.
    - 3) Dial the 4-digit number to which calls are to be forwarded.
    - 4) Press the Call forward (Call Fwd) button and the arrow will stay on steady.
    - 5) To verify the number to which calls are being forwarded, dial your own number from your own telephone. Your call should be forwarded to that number.

### 2) To Deactivate:

- a) On Single line and digital phones without Call Forward buttons:
  - 1) Lift the handset from the cradle.
  - 2) Dial the call forward deactivation code: \*73 (You will hear 2 short beeps).
  - 3) Replace the handset in the cradle.
- b) On digital phones with Call Forward buttons:
  - 1) With receiver in the cradle (hung up) press the Call Forward (Call Fwd) button.
  - 2) The arrow should disappear.
  - c) Call forward is deactivated; this can be verified by having someone call you if you're not sure.

### E. Ring Again:

#### To Activate:

- a) Lift the handset from the cradle.
  - b) Dial extension number, if line is busy
  - d) On single line phone, flash hook switch, get second dial tone, dial \*78, (if digital, press the RAG or Ring Again button )
  - e) Replace the handset in the cradle.
- NOTE: digital phones may continue to place or receive other calls while waiting for the ring again to recall
- f) Wait for ringing.
  - g) Lift the handset from the cradle and line will ring to called number, (or on digital press the RAG button).

### F. Voice Mail:

- 1) To check to see if you have a voice mail message, one of the following will occur:
  - a) On a single line phone you will receive a stuttered dial tone when the receiver is lifted or
  - b) On a digital phone you will have a MWT button, which will show an arrow when you have a message.
- 2) To retrieve your messages do one of the following:
  - a) Dial extension number 5980 on single line phones or
  - b) Press the MWT key on digital phone that will take you directly to voice mail.

\*Note- all of the following instructions apply to both types of phones (single line & digital).

- c) When voice mail picks up follow instructions, enter last 4 of your phone number & # then enter your password and # to access your messages.
- d) Follow prompts to listen to messages
- e) After finished replace handset in cradle.

- a) You will not receive a second dial tone after dialing "99" for off-base numbers or "94" for DSN numbers.
- b) You must dial all seven (7) digits. If the lines are busy, you will receive a busy tone.
